Choose one of the following to complete independently or with your group based on your book.

<p>THE HERO My Heroes Assignment</p>	<p>Research 3 of your favourite heroes, including one from the <i>Amazing Atlantic Canadian Kids</i> book. Create a short engaging presentation explaining why you chose each. What's their "superpower"? Do they have an "archvillain"? How are your heroes similar or different? Detailed Instructions</p>
<p>THE ACTIVIST Create a Campaign</p>	<p>Research a social justice topic you're passionate about and propose a social media campaign to rally support for it. Include compelling facts, memes, appropriate hashtags; etc. Most of all, explain why you feel this social justice topic is important. Detailed Instructions</p>
<p>THE ENTREPRENEUR Brand New Change</p>	<p>Consider creating your very own changemaking business and develop a presentation to share with the target audience. What product or service would you provide? What's different or new about this changemaking idea? Does it address a new need and if so, what is it? Who are your competitors? Top it off with creating a logo. Detailed Instructions</p>
<p>THE HUMANITARIAN Acts of Cyber Kindness</p>	<p>Everyone knows about cyber bullying. What about cyber kindness? Think about 5 random acts of cyber kindness you can commit to. Explain why you chose each and screenshot or record every instance of your kind acts online (anonymously or not!). Detailed Instructions</p>
<p>THE INVENTOR Dragon's Den Pitch</p>	<p>Imagine you're pitching an invention that benefits society to a group of Dragons, like on CBC's <i>Dragon's Den</i>. If possible, record yourself delivering your pitch on video with a cell phone. <i>One catch: one Dragon speaks French Canadian only!</i> Detailed Instructions</p>
<p>THE ADVENTURER Adventure Atlantic Online!</p>	<p>Develop a scavenger hunt that celebrates 5 awesome places to visit within Atlantic Canada. Use hyperlinks or URLs as well as Google maps to provide your clues. Detailed Instructions</p>
<p>THE ATHLETE Step By Step</p>	<p>Whether it's flipping a skateboard, riding a unicycle, or doing a cartwheel, detail how these moves are carried out, step by step. Take your own photos or a video if you're able, or source the appropriate images and videos on the web. Detailed Instructions</p>
